



Singapore Inline Cup 2008 Ranking rules & regulations

Main objective is to create more competition, bring up level of local athletes and created ranking based on performance.

We can't copy WIC or similar format since our races are not going to have constant group of participants and level of competition may vary greatly

Proposed system

- Allows athletes to miss a few races per season without serious negative effect on their ranking.
- Takes into consideration level of participants for each race
- Lets score points to majority of participants and get them involved in competition through the year.

Ranking

Athletes get ranking points based on the results of every race included in SIC calendar.

Points given taking into consideration:

- Placement (based on official race results)
- "Level of race" – taking into consideration current ranking of athletes participated in the race.



"Race Level" (F) = summary of ranking points of race participants divided by summary of ranking of all registered athletes (this figure is always in the range of 0 to 1).

Final points calculated as:

Placement points x (1 + F) x Race Ranking/100

Initial Rank of the race:

Base Rank – 100 points

+100 points if NISM

+ 50 points if SIC calendar race

By decision of Speed Committee Race Ranking can be changed (up to +/-50 points) base on subjective factors like importance of the event, intention to promote it, future prospect etc. This decision should be made not later than 45 days before the event.

Real Rank of the race:

M

Real Race Rank = Initial Race Rank X number of participants / by 20

W

Real Race Rank = Initial Race Rank X number of participants / by 10

If number of participants is less than 20 (M) and 10 (W), from Initial Race Ranking deducted 5% points (M) and 10% points (W) for each "missing" person.

If race had less than 10 participants (M) and less than 5 participants (W) there is no points awarded and race is not counted in overall ranking.

For NISM - each participant will get additional 10 points for every race regardless of final placement provided he has finished the race.

Overall SIC Individual Ranking:

- For each athlete all points scored in individual events are summarized. This is a current ranking.
- At the end of the season final ranking calculated based on up to 70% of all races.
- Ranking is only for SIC registered athletes.



Overall SIC Team Ranking:

- Team ranking is only for registered teams.
- Ranking points counted only after team registration.
- Team can be registered during the SIC season but ranking will start from "0" regardless how many points team members have scored individually since beginning of the SIC season.
- No changes allowed during the season.
- Team advised have own uniform.
- Max 5 persons per team (at least one female).
- For each team all points scored in individual events by team members are summarized (best 4 out of 5 athletes' scores regardless gender). This is a current ranking. At the end of the season final ranking calculated based on up to 70% of all races (best 4 out of 5 athletes' scores regardless gender).

Registration:

- 150 \$ – SIC 2008 team.
- 50 \$ - SIC 2008 Individual M.
- 30 \$ - SIC 2008 Individual W.
- 10 \$ - SIC 2008 Individual Kids

For SIC registered skaters only:

- SIC Ranking with points updated regularly.
- Sponsorship benefits (apparel, products, discounts etc).
- No registration fee for all events organised by RS.
- For non RS organised events registration fees may be subsidised (depending on the sponsorship/budget allocation).

Non-SIC registered skaters can take part in any SIC events by registering for particular race.

For some races registration fee will be imposed.

Registration forms will be sent to all clubs - ordinary RS members.

It also will be available for download on RS and Inlinekaki websites (to be confirmed).

Registrations for RS organised events will be accepted not later than 2* hours before the scheduled starting time of the race.

For events with heats (500m, 1,000 m) registrations accepted not later than 48 hours before the scheduled starting time of the race.

**Subject to adjustment based on requirements from timing service provider.*

No citizenship restrictions for all categories.

For all SIC events helmet is mandatory.

Hand protection is highly recommended as well as other protective



equipment.

This applies to every category except kids.

For kids - helmet, wrist guards, elbow guards and knee guards are mandatory.

Misc:

Ranking updated not later than 5 days after the race by person appointed by Speed Committee (ranking/calculation software will be provided)

By decision of Speed Committee other races/events can be included in ranking during SIC season. Application should be made not less than 5 weeks before the event and Speed Committee has to make decision not later than 7 days after receiving the application.

Speed Committee won't organise this event but provide help and advice to organisers if necessary.

Speed Committee will have at least one representative on the race day to observe and report to Committee.

Final results must be submitted to Speed Committee within the first working day after the race.

Speed committee has right to decide not to include race into SIC after feedback from SC representative. It has to make decision within two working days after the race.

Athletes participated in the last NISM under Speed category with placement within first 15 (M)/6 (W) in any race can only be registered under Race Cat for 2008 SIC.

After 3 top 3 finishes in Fitness Cat, Speed Committee has right to move athlete to Speed Cat.

If there are less than 5 participants per category (Juniors, Masters, Fitness) it will be cancelled. No awards/prizes for top 3, only best athlete will be recognized. It's applicable for single race as well as overall ranking.

**We are unable to confirm prizes at this moment.*

Details for prizes under overall SIC ranking will be announced not later than April.

Details for single race prizes will be announced as early as possible, depending on SSC budget allocation in March and sponsorship deals.
